



Requirements for Reciprocal Auctioneer Licensing

In order to be considered for a Reciprocal Auctioneer License you must reside in Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, or West Virginia. You must be an active licensed auctioneer in your state of residence. Please use this checklist to insure that you have complied with all requirements.

- _____ Application form: completed, signed and notarized
- _____ Oath of office form: completed, signed and notarized
- _____ Irrevocable Consent Form: signed and notarized
- _____ Notarized copy of your voter registration card
- _____ Letters of Good Standing from *each* jurisdiction you hold an auction or auction business license
- _____ Obtain and submit a Surety Bond in favor of the Louisiana Auctioneers Board in the Amount of \$10,000. All bonds must run concurrent with the licensing period ending December 31st. The original must be submitted.
- _____ Submit proof from the Louisiana Department of Revenue that you are registered to pay Louisiana sales tax if you own your own auction business.
- _____ Submit a passport size photograph taken within the past 6 months
- _____ Fees: certified check or money order payable to the Louisiana Auctioneers Board for \$300 OR if you reside in Florida you must pay \$330; if you reside in Georgia you must pay \$350. These fees are set by the Reciprocal Agreement between the states involved. If you were previously licensed in Louisiana and your license has been expired for more than 12 months, you must pay the additional \$100 license restoration fee.

Louisiana has an Auction Business licensing requirement. If your auction business is entering Louisiana to hold auctions, you must also have an Auction Business license. If you will be working for a Louisiana based auction business, you are not required to have an Auction Business license. (Arkansas, S. Carolina, and Texas licensees are exempt from being required to hold a separate Business license in Louisiana.)

All license applications are considered at regularly scheduled board meetings. Applications are due 2 weeks before the board meeting. Please visit our website to view board meeting dates.

Please note all licenses run January 1st through December 31st. License fees are not pro-rated and are non-refundable.
